

## Jingdezhen Ceramics Tour 3 days

Visit the porcelain city and learn the history of China's fine ceramics

Destination: Jingdezhen, JiangXi

Transportation: G speed train + coach + G speed train



### Overview

Known as the “Porcelain City”, Jingdezhen was the designated source for all porcelain goods in the Imperial household for over 900 years. It has a history of porcelain making dating back nearly two millennia. The majority of the world’s fine Chinese ceramics dating from that time can be traced to Jingdezhen’s workshops. Today Jingdezhen remains a major source of ceramic goods found around the world.

“Jingdezhen Ceramics Tour” gives us an opportunity to see the ancient wood-fired kilns, learn the history of China’s fine ceramics, in addition to see contemporary ceramic art studio.

**Jingdezhen discovery (Breakfast/Lunch)**

08:30      Departure

08:45-10:45 Jingdezhen Ancient Kiln and Ceramic Museum of Folk customs  
Here you can find classically trained pottery masters making porcelain in the traditional manner and pass by the huge kilns that were once used to make the emperor's prized possession. The Ceramic Folklore Museum is like a living timeline of the history of porcelain. Delicately preserved fine China show the evolution of porcelain style and technique that varied from dynasty to dynasty. The museum has also two beautiful Ming Garden and Qing Garden.

10:45-11:00 Drive to Imperial Porcelain Archaeology Museum

11:00-12:15 Imperial Porcelain Archaeology Museum

Several feet below the earth's surface, the Imperial Kiln is undergoing an archaeological excavation. Shards and remnants of the porcelain made in this giant kiln are still being found and archaeologists are using this opportunity to document the history of China's porcelain culture.

12:15      Drive to San Bao International Ceramic Village

12:45-13:30 Lunch at a local restaurant, San Bao International Ceramic Village

13:30-14:00 Visit ceramic artist studio, San Bao International Ceramic Village

Jingdezhen attracts many ceramic artists to have their workshop or studio there. Some are award-winning artists. We will visit ceramic artists and hear the story behind their art pieces.

- 14:00-15:00 Pottery making DIY experience, you can make the pottery by yourself with the instruction of local ceramic master  
Walk around; visit the San Bao International Ceramic Village Museum and work shop
- 17:00 Drive approx. 30 min to TaoXiChuan Ceramic Art Area
- 17:30-18:30 Ceramic Art Avenue Art Gallery  
Ceramic Art Avenue Art Gallery is located in Ceramic Art Avenue, is a landmark building and a key project of cultural development. It is in the original building style of "Universal Porcelain Factory" of "Ten Great State-owned Porcelain Factories" in Jing De Zhen City
- 18:30 Visit Saturday night market in TaoXiChuan Ceramic Art Area on your own
